1200. APOLOGIES

1201. PLANNING

a) applications 07/00275/ful Mile Hill House Langport Road Fivehead. The erection of a dwelling for occupation by a disabled person. GR 334387/123170).

After considerable debate and taking into consideration the written thoughts of councillors HC & GB who were unable to be present it was resolved to submit the following observations:

“1. The site plan is quite inadequate and to the best of Council’s knowledge is inaccurate. Council would like to see a copy of the plan for the whole site as it is at the current time.

The Parish Council:-

2. is concerned about this application given the applicant’s past history with the Planning Office and breach of planning conditions.
3. would like further medical evidence to confirm what is in The Access Design and Statement.
4. is concerned about the access and the already agreed parking and turning facilities for the applicant’s existing business.
5. ask is disability is a planning issue?
6. ask is the proposed dwelling outside the development line?

7 In conclusion the information supplied with this application is insufficient to allow Council to come to a decision.

Council suggests a site meeting to clarify all these issues.”
