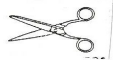
Time to top up our tanks in the New Year.

The other morning the Graham household awoke to a rather unpleasant surprise – our boiler was thoroughly clogged with soot and was busy making a fine mess of our back wall not to mention creating a rather unpleasant aroma in the house! One might say that this turn of events is all 'part of life's rich tapestry' seeing that some surprises are welcome while others, like this and other more serious things, we could do without!

As a Pastor reflecting on the Christmas story (which will probably not surprise you!) it struck me that there are a variety of surprises in there and they are not all pleasant ones. ## **A million voices for nature**

**RSPB Somerset Reserves  
MUSHROOM MAGIC AND A MUCKY MESS!**

What a great start to the autumn! We held two very successful events in October. For Mushroom magic we were privileged to have national fungi expert Michael Jordan leading 22 keen foragers around Swell Wood. After a joint foraging effort by all attendees, 30 species of fungi including Russulas, Boletes and a rather aptly named Herald of Winter were found and identified. On Feed the Birds Day the birds were unusually few and far between in the woodland, probably due to the warm weather and excess of insects still around, so after a leisurely walk in Swell Wood twenty-five people, including a number of children, came down to Dewlands Farm to refreshments and the making of bird feeders and, most favourite activity, filling fat logs with seedy, peanutty lard. This wonderful, greasy messy activity was much enjoyed by our younger visitors! Replete with two feeders and some seeds and peanuts to start them off, a number of families will now be keeping their garden birds a lot happier this winter. Why not take a look at the RSPB webpages at <http://www.rspb.org.uk/hfw/index.aspx> and find out all about our Homes for Wildlife. You can download instructions on how to build a wildlife stack, somewhere for your garden insects to overwinter, and perhaps even sign up for tailored-made advice for your garden.

If you missed all this fun, why not catch up with one of our other **walks this winter** at West Sedgemoor, Greylake and Ham Wall. We've got Birdwatching for Beginners at **Greylake** (20 Nov and 12 Feb), Ducktastic at **West Sedgemoor** (4, 14, 26, 31 Dec and 18 Jan, 15 and 26 Feb), and of course our 'Big Wetland Duckwatch' on Saturday 28 January as part of our national Big Garden Birdwatch weekend. And don't forget **Ham Wall** near Glastonbury for Winter Wetland Safaris (16 Nov, 11 Dec, 15 Jan, 5 Feb) and Birdwatching for Beginners (23 Nov, 11 & 22 Jan, 15 Feb, 4 & 14 March). 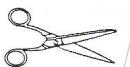
